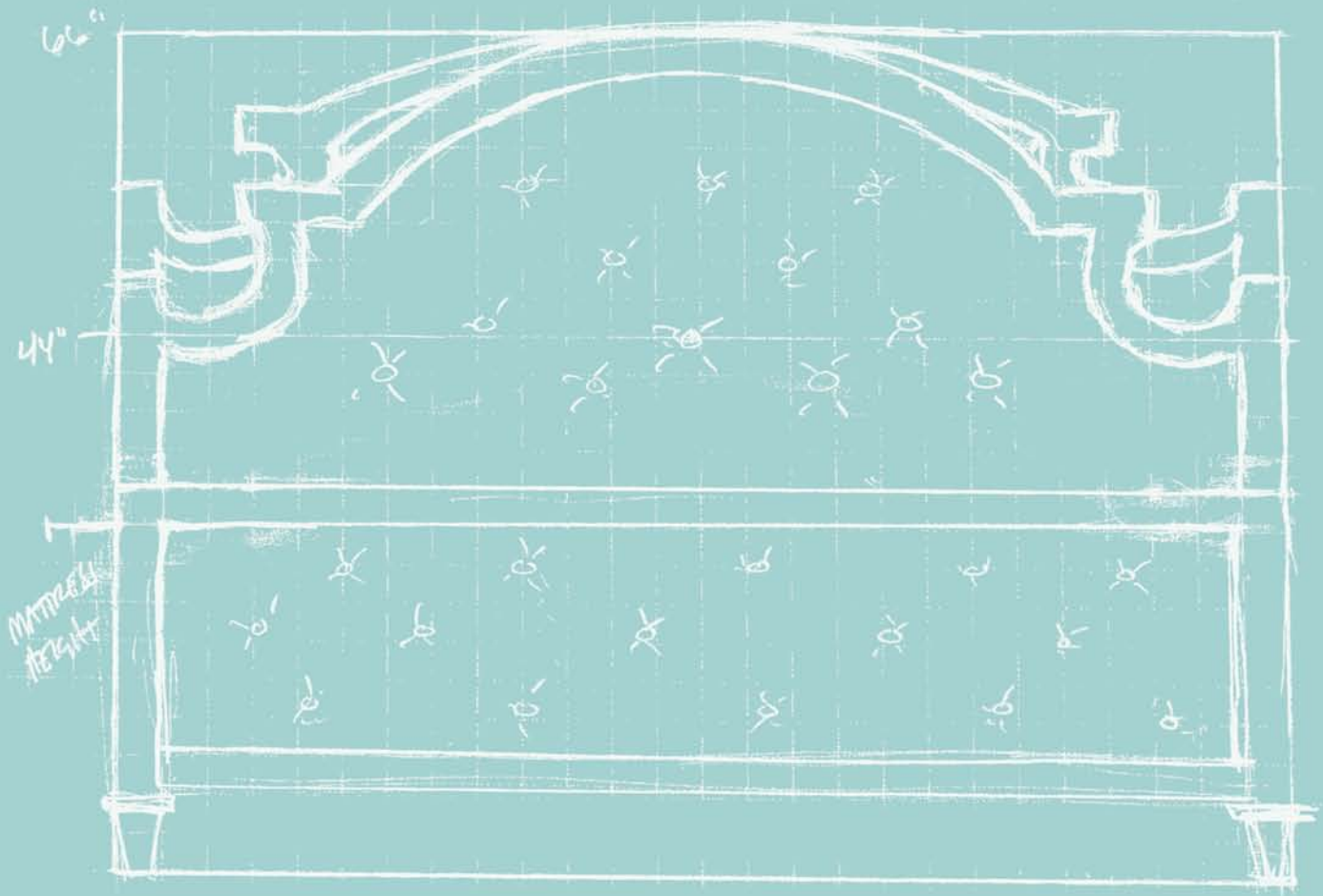
# avery cabinet

We loved the simplicity of this design and wanted a furniture piece incorporating these elements. Finding the perfect metal brackets and hardware for the piece proved to be challenging, as we needed just the right detail to tie together the simplicity of the mirror with the exotic flair of the Chinese Chippendale base.



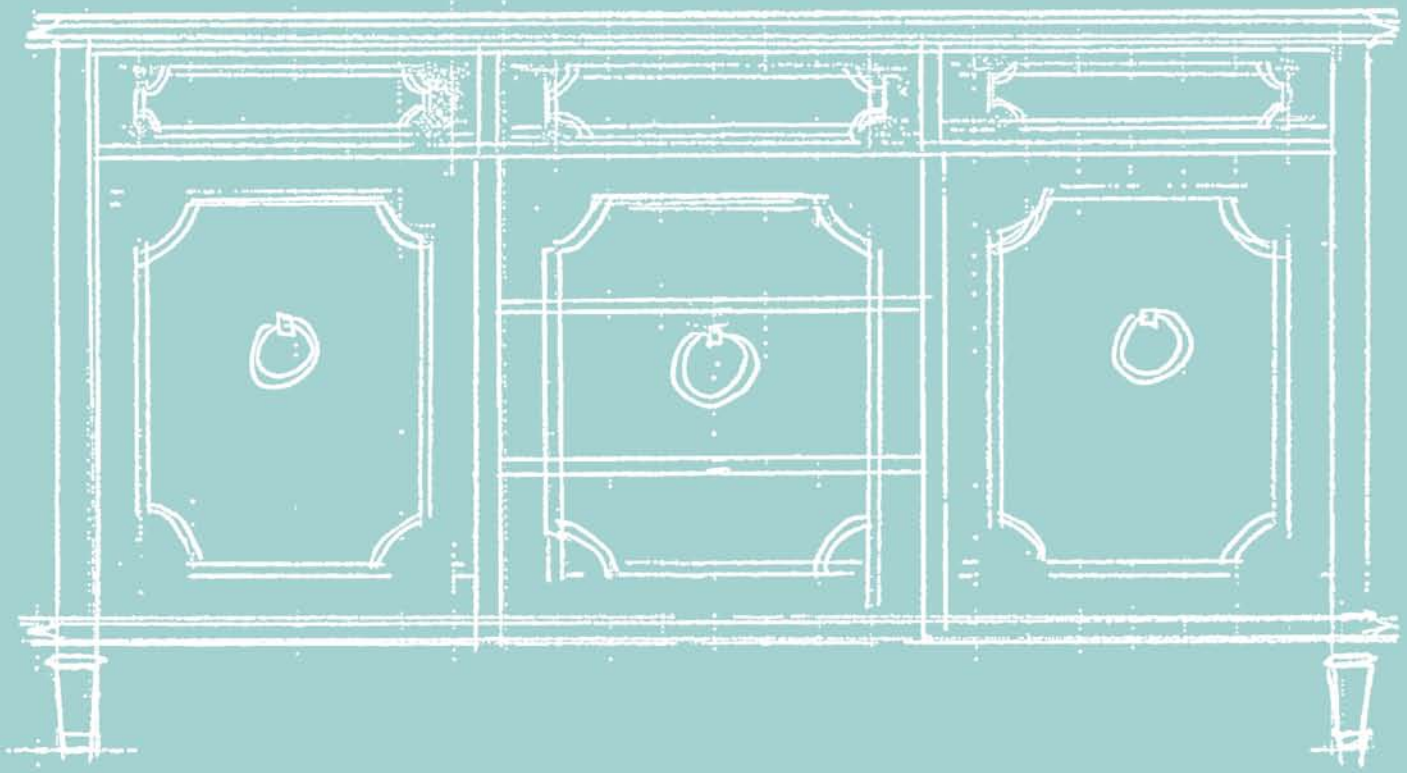
# channing bed



The Channing Bed was initially created for the famous Los Angeles wedding and event planner Mindy Weiss and photographed for a feature story in *O at Home Magazine*. An archway in her 1930s Spanish style home inspired the shape of the button tufted headboard, to which we added the Regency elements to bring in a little glamour. The design was incorporated into the Grace Home Collection® and shown in a feature on upholstered headboards in the September 2009 issue of *House Beautiful Magazine*.



# ambassador buffet

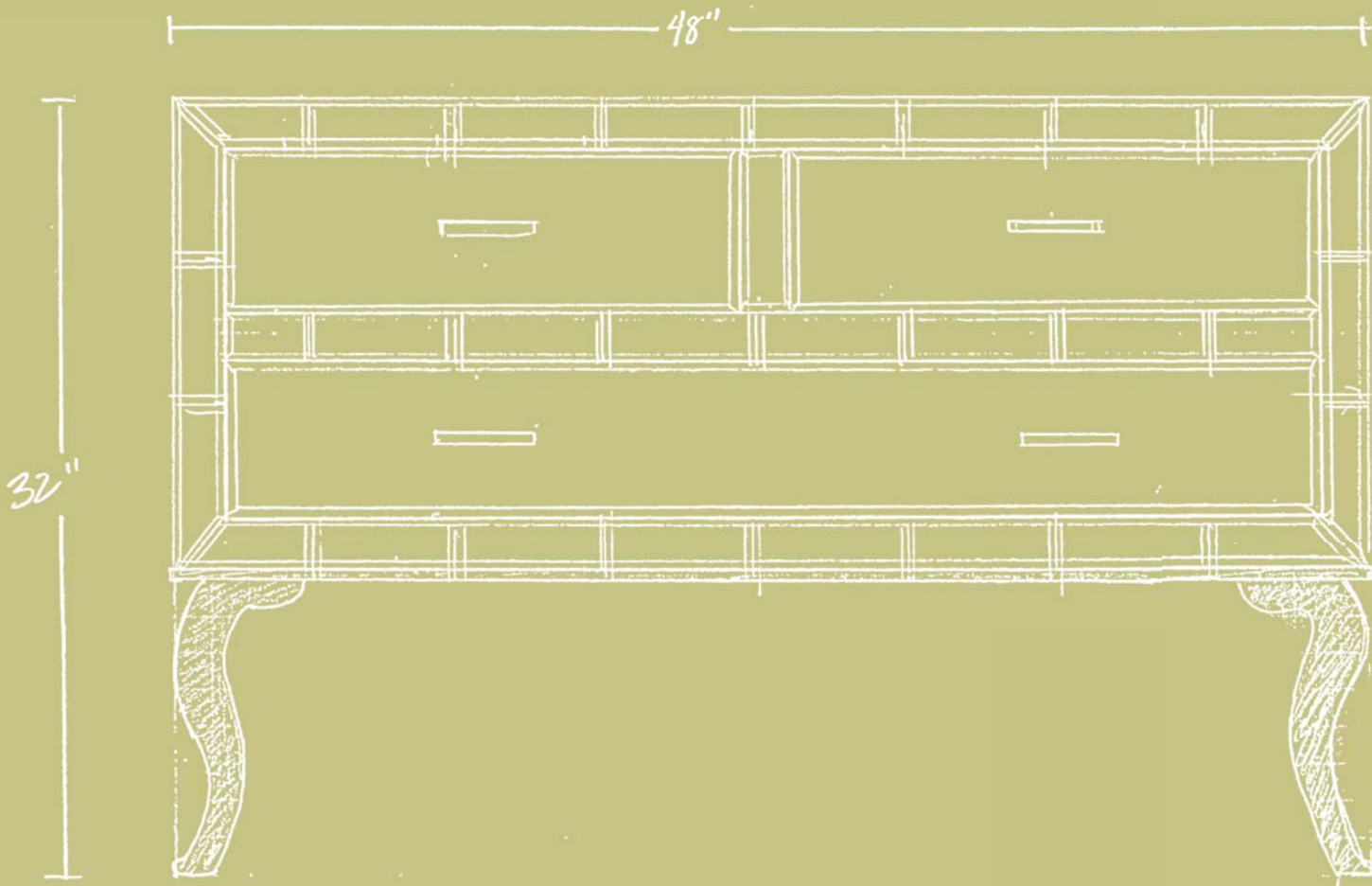

The finish on the original piece was black with brass ormolu and large decorative brass hardware. We freshened the look on the new design by replacing the excessive decorative hardware with clean modern ring pulls in polished nickel. # hayworth night chest



The Hayworth Night Chest is based on an English antique chest purchased on a buying excursion to London's famous antique row, Church Street. The original piece was a cabriole-legged lowboy chest of drawers from the late 1800s that was updated with mirror sometime in the 1930s or 1940s. The marriage of the classic cabriole leg and the mid-century mirrored element creates a look that is at once traditional and contemporary, hard-edged and curvaceous.

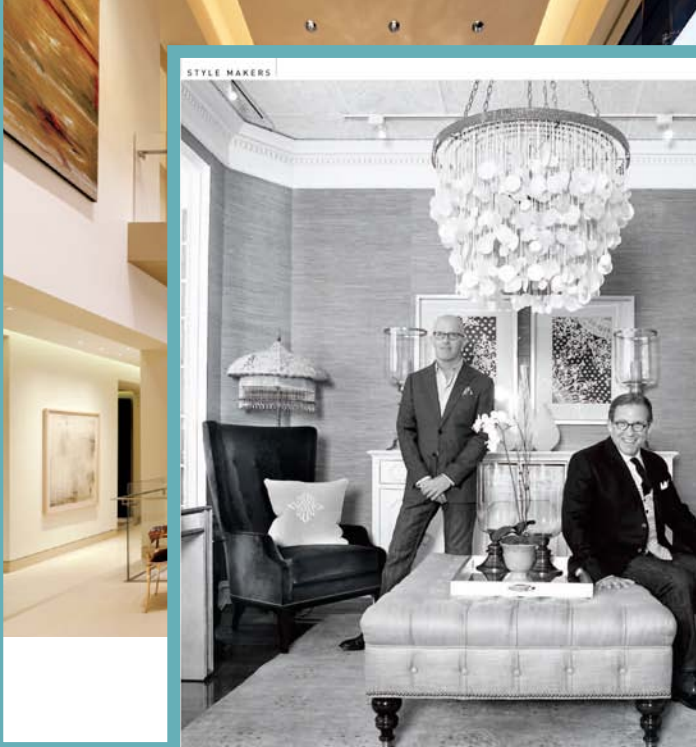

It's fitting that Michael Ostrow and Roger Stoker of Grace Home Furnishings met over the sale of a table, some 16 years ago. Michael was manning the shop Roger was buying. Now, as partners in business and in life, the pair is celebrating the 10-year anniversary of their three-fold company—a retail shop, a collection of mostly upholstered items and case goods—"inspired by the past but adapted to the present," says Ostrow—and a design firm serving a lumina clientele including Madonna and Heidi Klum and Seal. At their 3,000-square-foot showroom provided over by a frisky chocolate Lab named Grace (a successor to the late Grace, who reached celebrity status in the design community), expect to see a casual yet refined update on glamorous classics. "We base our designs on historic pieces we've found," says Stoker. "Architecturally speaking, Los Angeles is a young city, but there are treasure troves of architecture and design being discovered and preserved every day." 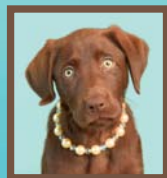
